Dr Nikki Alexander (Emelia Fox), Dr Jack Hodgson (David Caves), Dr Thomas Chamberlain (Richard Lintern) and Dr Clarissa Mullery (Liz Carr) have now meshed into a compelling, dynamic, but all-too-human unit. Together these very different characters pool their formidable resources in pursuit of truth and justice... even if they don't always agree on what those terms constitute.

This 3x60 series follows actor Miriam Margolyes, dancer Wayne Sleep, actor Sylvester McCoy, comedian Roy Walker, chef Rosemary Shrager, darts champion Bobby George, singer Patti Boulaye, and ex-news reader Jan Leeming as they head to India to see if they can set up a better, more rewarding retirement there than in the UK.

As they take over a mansion in Jaipur, they discuss who will cook and clean and how they'll get around and spend their time.

Initially they're unsettled by the realities of life in India: hectic roads, animals in the street, and poor toilet facilities. The heat and hard work has them considering whether they can do this alone or need to take advantage of cheap staff costs. Miriam keeps their spirits up with her great one-liners and fun observations.

Jaipur has hundreds of years of history, and they head out to one of its impressive buildings - the 500 year old Amer Fort. Their guide shows them his home nearby and they begin to understand the gulf between rich and poor and the impact of the caste system.

They're invited to tea with Jaipur's royal family at the opulent Rambagh Palace where they get to mix with high society.

Wayne explores his spiritual side by attending the daily morning prayers and visiting the beautiful Galti Ji temple which is also home to a troop of monkeys, while Rosemary, finding it hard to unwind, tries meditation for the first time.

To end their first week, they throw a party and perform to their new neighbours as they begin to feel at home.

Janet King: The Long Goodbye

Final

A few days after the Royal Commission is suspended, the container of guns is collected and a camera inside reveals the surprise identity of the ringleader.

Owen (Damian Walshe-Howling) follows him to a clandestine meeting, giving Janet (Marta Dusseldorp) proof that the corruption has spread to big business and government, and will ultimately bring down the biggest political scalp of all.

But until she's cleared at Corruption Commission, she can't go public with the findings. Tony (Peter Kowitz) steps in and cleverly traps the Commission with their own charter, and the investigation is dropped.

Janet's now free to expose the extent of the corruption and criminality in the importation and distribution of the guns, but the gunrunner has one more ace up his sleeve. He claims he knows who killed Ash, and warns they're planning an attack on Janet soon.

But when DNA findings reveal genetic markers for Androgen Insensitivity Syndrome - meaning the killer is female - Bianca (Anita Hegh) is convinced it's Heather (Leah Purcell). And they have enough to arrest her as they wait for DNA confirmation.

Richard (Hamish Michael) represents Heather at her bail hearing, but when the full face morphology results arrive, the identity of Ash's killer is revealed to be someone who was not only in front of Janet the entire time, but someone with access to her children, and with whom she is now trapped inside the empty Commission building. Now Janet has to fight to save her children and herself...
