Fresh Blood Pilot Season: Why Are You Like This?

FRESH BLOOD is a ground-breaking ABC and Screen Australia initiative that seeks to uncover the next generation of Australian comedy talent. First launched in 2013, there were hundreds of entries from all over the country that culminated in the Wham Bam Thankyou Ma'am and Fancy Boy sketch series (both co-produced with NBCU's Seeso streaming platform (U.S.). Once again in 2017, 20 up-and-coming comedy teams were given \$15,000 each to produce a 3x5 minute comedy project. This year, four of those were chosen to produce a half hour comedy pilot, with one or possibly two projects to be commissioned to make a 6-part series.

Why Are You Like This:

Best friends Penny and Mia are navigating their 20s in Melbourne. Guided by their own modern day moral code they confront complex social issues in an outrage-driven world, leaving a path of destruction in their wake. Mia is fired from her job for being objectively bad at it, and fights against it until she realises she'll be paid out.

Meanwhile, Penny's RUOK day lecture is highjacked by coworker, Daniel, who turns her feelings workshop into a bros night. After a collective bad day, the girls head out to see Penny's housemate, Austin, perform as his drag alter-ego JonBenet RamsMe.

Once Mia realises her severance pay won't get her as far as she thought, she tries her hand at a few different jobs, but none of them afford her the amount of freedom she demands. After a follow-up conversation with Daniel, Penny is suspicious that he may be homophobic, and is determined to prove it. After getting the evidence she needs, she sets out to destroy him with Austin and Mia's help.

At Penny's office staff party, Mia discovers she can have her cake and eat it too by bullying men for money (in a consensual way). With Austin's guidance, Penny calls Daniel out in front of the whole office, but it all comes crashing down when Austin realises he's met Daniel before... on Grindr. Penny finds herself at sensitivity training (somewhere she never thought she'd end up) and Mia is raking in the cash after finding a man who she mistakenly believes is enjoying the experience - Penny's boss.

Episode 5: Entente Cordiale

Victoria (Jenna Coleman) sets sail on her first voyage to the continent to try her hand at foreign diplomacy – confident that she will be able to rescue Anglo-French relations by deterring the wily King of the French, Louis Philippe, from forming a potentially dangerous allegiance with Spain through the marriage of his son to the Spanish Queen.

It's an adventure for the whole court, royals and servants alike, but Victoria quickly realises that she will need to have her wits about her if she is to make the charming, but not altogether trustworthy, Louis Philippe (Bruno Wolkowitch), take her seriously as Queen.
