ABC sweeps 7th AACTA Awards with seven wins

A staggering five ABC programs won their category at the 7th AACTA Awards ceremony this week in Sydney. The ABC wishes to congratulate all the nominees and winners whose vision and talents contribute to the extraordinarily strong TV industry in Australia.
