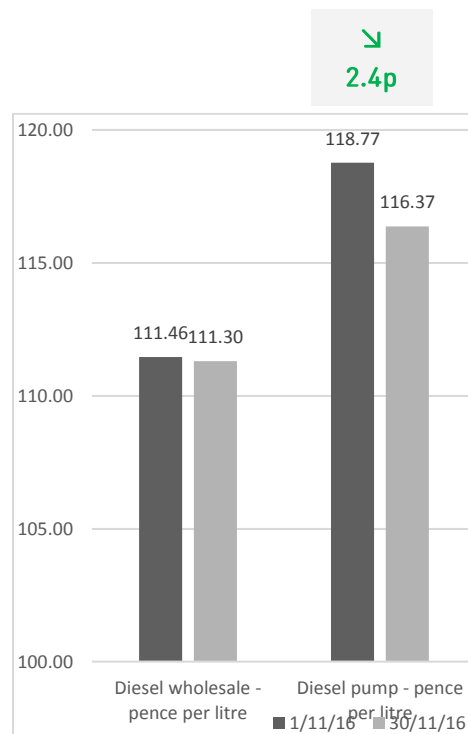
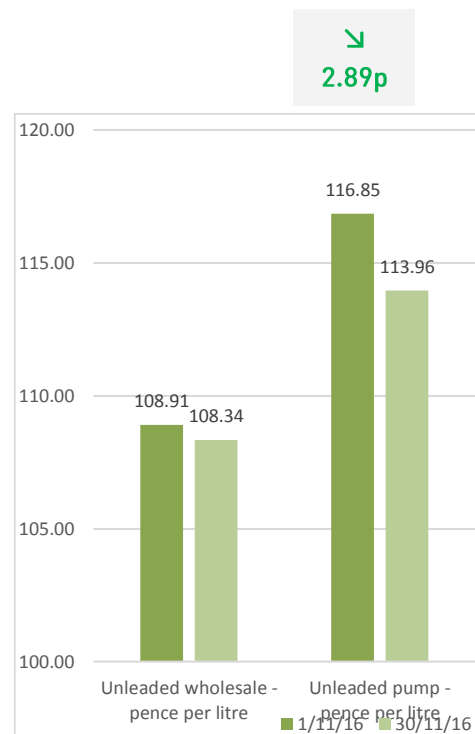
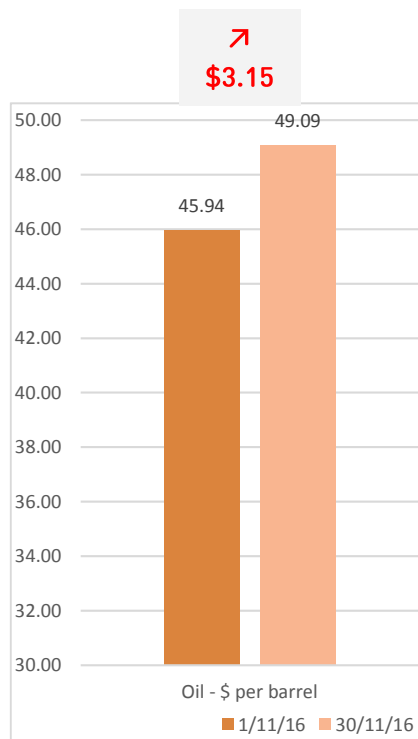


UK fuel prices in November 2016

Our view on prices

"While November was a good month for fuel prices with the first reduction for four months, it looks as though motorists are about to have an unwelcome early Christmas present in the form of higher prices at the pump. This is a big change from the last two Decembers when drivers benefited from falling fuel prices.

"The medium-term outlook for prices is, however, much harder to predict. What happens to the oil price in the next few weeks as the markets react will be crucial."
