STATEMENT

Israeli forces kill former MSF colleague Abdullah Hammad – 12th loss for the organisation in Gaza since October 2023

Medecins Sans Frontieres (MSF) mourns and condemns the loss of former colleague Abdullah Hammad, who was killed by Israeli forces on 3 July. Israeli forces deliberately targeted a group of people, including Abdullah, without warning as they waited for aid trucks.

At least 16 people were killed in total, according to medical teams at Nasser hospital. The group had been desperately hoping to collect flour from an aid truck in Khan Younis, southern Gaza, next to a desalination plant in the area, where a similar incident took place on 17 June. Abdullah was a hygienist who worked in Al Mawasi clinic for a year and a half until 30 June. MSF is appalled and deeply saddened by this atrocious tragedy.

At this time our thoughts are with Abdullah's family, including his sister Zainab, and his two brothers, Karam and Bahaa, who also work for MSF, along with all our MSF colleagues in Gaza with whom we mourn his death and stand_during this extremely difficult time. In addition to the loss of Abdullah, MSF has already lost 11 colleagues since October 2023. We demand an end to this bloodshed.

"On 3 July, Israeli forces committed yet another massacre, targeting a group of people hopelessly trying to collect bags of flour off an aid truck in southern Gaza. This appalling tragedy killed at least 16 people, including former MSF colleague Abdullah Hammad. The actual number of people killed is likely to be much higher as Israeli forces refused to allow dead bodies to be retrieved from the site. The Israeli forces then ordered people who were trying to collect flour to leave immediately.

The level of desperation for food inside Gaza is now beyond comprehension. Humanitarian agencies' ability to respond to the gaping needs is restricted to the bare minimum. Israeli authorities are limiting movements and supplies and have devised a new militarised way to distribute food that is degrading and deadly. The systemic and deliberate starvation of Palestinians for over 100 days is pushing people in Gaza to breaking point. This carnage must stop now."

STAFF TESTIMONY

By AbdAllah*, another MSF colleague who survived the Israeli attack on people seeking aid in Khan Younis, southern Gaza, on 3 July:

"We went to Khan Younis as we heard there would be aid trucks there. There were already a lot of people there. Five trucks were parked to let people come in and take what they could. Then the [Israeli] tanks started advancing and we could see a lot of snipers in the area too. Suddenly shots started coming from every direction. Whomever got a bag of flour, got shot in the head. The bags of flour were all over the ground. Covered in blood. There were so many bodies on the ground. After that, a quadcopter came to where we were hiding under the rubble of one of the houses. [The quadcopter] told us to put our hands up and come out. It said "you are not allowed to take flour. Keep walking and don't pick up any of the dead or wounded from the ground. Some people stayed, we could still hear the tanks firing. Young men, dying for a bag of flour."

(0:01) Five trucks were let in and people were allowed to come to take what's in them. (0:05) Then the tanks advanced to that area, (0:10) and there were a lot of snipers. (0:12) The shots was coming from every direction. (0:15) The tanks were firing, the snipers were shooting. (0:18) Whomever grabs a bag of flour gets was shot in the head. (0:20) The bags of flour were spread all over the ground. (0:22) There was a lot of blood. (0:24) Alot of people left were left on the ground. (0:29) Some of them had unidentified features. (0:31) because all the shots hit people in their heads. (0:33) A lot of snipers were there specifically for this purpose. (0:37) They targeted all the people who were there. (0:40) Some people were able to take the flour and leave. (0:44) But all the bags of flour were soaked in blood. (0:46) Whomever managed to secure a bag of flour, (0:47) their bag would be full of blood. (0:50) [Israeli force said:] Keep walking. You are not allowed to pick up the bodies of the dead or the wounded from the ground. (0:56) The tanks kept firing. (0:58) It was very difficult. (1:00) People were hungry. They needed to eat. (1:03) I swear to God, it was devastating. (1:06) Lives are worthless there. Young men there (1:14) were dying for a bag of flour.
