COACHES CORNER: In his career Marc Trestman is 3-0 coaching against Ottawa. He was coaching the Chicago Bears when the Redblacks entered the league. Conversely, Rick Campbell's record against the Argos is 3-8, his most losses against any team.

HISTORY COULD BE MADE TODAY: Two weeks ago against Montreal, James Franklin set the Argos team record for single-season rushing TDs, breaking the record that had been shared by Robert Drummond and Gill 'The Thrill' Fenerty. Franklin's 14 rushing TDs has tied the CFL record for rushing TDs by a QB in one season. Doug Flutie rushed for 14 in 1991 with the B.C. Lions. Franklin is just one ahead of Mike Reilly, who has 13 this season.

FOLLOW THE LEADER: Franklin leads all non-kickers with 86 points on 14 TDs and one two-point conversion. Mike Reilly is second with 78 (13 TD), Andrew Harris third with 66 (8 TD, three two-point conversions).

LEAGUE LEADERS: There aren't too many league categories the Argos lead this season. They are number one in the league in red-zone defence, limiting opponents to a 49.2% TD success rate, the only team under 50% in the league. They also have held opponents to an average kickoff return of 19.5 yards per return, the only team with an average below 20 yards.

S.J. LOVES TD: S.J. Green must be developing a love for TD Place. Not only did his catch on a second-and-ten extend the eventual game-winning drive in the Grey Cup game, but he set a career mark there last year in the regular season. On July 8th he caught 10 passes from Ricky Ray for 210 yards, his career high for single game receiving yards. He scored one touchdown that night.

CAPITAL CONNECTIONS: Argo left guard Tyler Holmes played at Merivale High School. His dad, Richard, was an All-Star running back for the Rough Riders 1977-79. The other Ottawa native on the team is defensive end John Biewald who played at Ashbury College.

- The Argos could have two players go over the 1,000-yard receiving mark tonight. S.J. Green needs just 19 yards, while Armanti Edwards is 103 yards shy of the plateau.
