Inside Men

Series Premiere

A thrilling drama about three employees of a security depot who plan and execute a multi-million pound cash heist.

John (Steven Mackintosh), Chris (Ashley Walters) and Marcus (Warren Brown) are three ordinary men who work in a security depot. Every day they watch as millions of pounds worth of cash is counted, bound and stored in a vault. They see more money than they could ever dream of earning slowly pass them by.

John, a manager, is a quiet man. He's married to Kirsty and they have recently adopted a child, Olivia. As honest as they come, John always makes sure his books balance – no money is ever taken on his watch, and the few times it has been, John has topped up the balance with money from his own pocket.
