Sando

Inside her new pool house digs, Eric (Dylan Hesp) makes Sando (Sacha Horler) a little uncomfortable with his over-personal offers of teeth flossing and towel drying, while her stopover weighs heavily on Susie (Krew Boylan), who chastises husband Gary (Uli Latukefu) for craving to 'comfort' her. Banished to the kitchen, Gary discovers Susie's dad Don (Phil Lloyd) and Susie's live-in best friend Nicky (Adele Vuko) 'comforting' each other in the pantry, and must now decide whether saving Susie from distress by withholding that revelation from her is worth breaching his wedding vows to always tell Susie everything.

While Don and Nicky stay trapped in the cupboard, Susie and Sando enter the kitchen, forcing Gary to take evasive action. Susie confronts her mum for never apologising for sleeping with Susie's one-time fiancé Kevin (Firass Dirani), as Sando realises she's physically incapable of apologising for anything.

It's also Sando's week with Vic Jnr (Zane Ciarma) – her son with Susie's ex fiancé Kevin – and he bunks in Eric's room, complete with Star Wars memorabilia and an extensive Lego collection. Jealous of Sando's and Vic Jnr's relationship, Eric asks Sando to a movie but she instead encourages him to take Vic Jnr. Vic Jnr decides to mark his territory, pranking Eric into believing he's been kidnapped and ensuring they both know where they stand.

Sando, meanwhile, continues to try to win over Susie, who downloads to Nicky about all Susie's annoying habits. Which only serves to clarify exactly how similar Sando and Susie really are. Susie then accepts a genuine apology from Kevin, infuriating Sando, who decides to pull out all stops and commissions an apology video (from a famous Australian TV star) to exhibit to the family on 'Sunday-take-out and-movie-night'. But just when Susie begins to come around, Sando screws it all up again... simply by being herself.

He returns to the scene of the crime and discovers several more bones from Sally's skeleton, and a camera, lodged in a tree.

Call The Midwife

Dr Turner fights to get Rhoda and Bernie Mullucks, (whose daughter Susan was born without limbs in series 5), the necessary support now that Susan's problems are becoming more obvious the older she gets. Dr Turner refers Susan to the Limb Fitting Unit at Queen Mary's Hospital, Roehampton, where children like Susan are fitted with artificial limbs.

The prosthetics are cumbersome and terrifying but nevertheless the visit goes someway to normalise the situation for Rhoda, when she meets another mother of a Thalidomide affected child. But for Bernie, the visit leaves him traumatised by the reminder that his daughter is so profoundly disabled and he finally blames Rhoda for taking the pills.

It seems as if Rhoda and Bernie may never be able to put things right, unless they find a way to focus their anger outside of their loving family. Elsewhere, Nurse Crane relishes delivering a fourth son to the rumbustious mixed-race Antoine family. Nurse Crane is a little protective over the Antoine brothers, who have been the recent victim of racist jibes at cubs. Sister Winifred's driving has scarcely progressed at all, and after one particularly confusing session, Nurse Crane takes matters in hand, with distressing and far-reaching consequences.

Afterwards, Nurse Crane experiences some of the darkest days of her life. Elsewhere, Trixie becomes increasingly suspicious of Christopher Dockerill after a series of cancelled dates and an erroneous item of woman's clothing found in his car. She eventually confronts him and is shocked by his frank disclosure. Compelled to be honest herself, Trixie decides that it's time to come clean about her own secret past.
