Maddie Parry: Brothel Hostess

ABC2 spends a week looking at 'the business of sex', from sex work to porn to stripping to sex in gaming. Examining the sex industry both in Australia, and around the world, a range of documentaries look closely at the connection between sex and money, and the consequences for young relationships.

In this new series by young Australian journalist Maddie Parry, we see Maddie tackle working in some of Australia's



most controversial workplaces. She unpacks stereotypes and must battle her own prejudices while searching for the truth of these polarising issues. In Maddie Parry: Brothel Hostess, Maddie goes looking for love in one of Melbourne's oldest and largest brothels. Working as a hostess, she meets sassy sex worker Rachael, who claims women will always be objectified so she may as well make money from it. And Charlie, a man who has paid almost 100 women, says it's a performance, just like going to the cinema. The women at the brothel have trouble trusting men, and after a few weeks, Maddie can understand why. It seems the ladies are right - men pay outside of the brothel too, providing 'love' in return for sex. At first shocked, Maddie wonders if she's been naïve. But as she clocks up hours on night shift, she discovers the men are paying for far more than just sex; they too want intimacy. Is intimacy really for sale? What is the cost for women when they provide a 'special connection' along with hot sex? And can this connection be real? Maddie meets Ben, a man who has fallen in love with his regular sex worker. She worries Ben has fallen for an act - is he being fooled? Maddie sets out to find out but while investigating the desires of the ladies and their clients she finds herself questioning her own relationship with love.

Back Roads: Winton

Heather Ewart arrives in the Western Queensland town of Winton on race day eve and the place is buzzing. Winton has a rich history, it's where Banjo Patterson was inspired to write *Waltzing Matilda* and where Qantas held its first board meeting.

Winton's fortunes have always been tied to the land. With decades of drought and increasing debt, many have been forced off their farms and the town's population is now only a third of what it was in its heyday.

Heather finds a community that won't go down without a very big fight. They're trying to reinvent themselves, with a future built on the bones of dinosaurs, tourism and a film industry.

Heather meets the remarkable David Elliott, a third generation grazier who stumbled across dinosaur bones in his paddock 16 years ago. It was a life-changing moment for him and the fortunes of the town. He's the driving force behind The Australian Age of Dinosaurs Museum that has attracted some powerful backers, including former Governor-General Dame Quentin Bryce, the patron and a frequent visitor.

Quentin Bryce grew up in Western Queensland after her mother started working as a teacher in Winton in the thirties and met her father there.

"My heart thumps when I arrive on a plane in the central west," shares Quentin Bryce.

Heather also meets mother of four, Joy McClymont. She's started an online health and fitness business, helping fellow farmers get fit and cope with drought stress. Joy inspires her clients to exercise with what they have - irrigation pipes, crow bars and to run laps around their dams. That survival instinct can be found everywhere in Winton.

ABC2 spends a week looking at 'the business of sex', from sex work to porn to stripping to sex in gaming. Examining the sex industry both in Australia, and around the world, a range of documentaries look closely at the connection between sex and money, and the consequences for young relationships.

An estimated 1 in 10 British men regularly pay for sex. In the heart of Sheffield is the so-called golden mile of sex, with the highest concentration of massage parlours in the city. A Very British Brothel reveals the day-to-day workings of the only parlour in the street run by a mother and daughter duo. Operating in a converted pub, their premises specialises in the services of more mature women. The documentary reveals the struggle to fill the daily rota, how the management deal with problem clients, and the lives of the working girls who advertise their services and for whom sex is just a job.
