One Zoo Three season 1 premiered on CBBC and BBC i-player in September 2020 and has gone from strength to strength with a total of 50+ episodes, a spin off OZT Goes Wild in Britain 5 x 28' series and a Broadcast Digital Highly Commended Award in 2024.

In season 4 the brothers headed to San Diego Zoo in the USA coming face to face with Komodo Dragons, Galapagos Tortoises and Polar Bears and now in the brand-new Season 5 brothers Cam, Tyler and Aaron head to Belgium Pairi Daiza Zoo for an ultra-cool mission to learn how animals have adapted to survive in the coldest places on earth. Here they meet Emperor Penguins, huge Walrus's and the endangered Golden Takin.

With global wildlife conservation at the heart of this series, 10 exciting fun and factual episodes show the inspiring work being done at the One Zoo Three zoo with its cat sanctuary in the UK and many more other amazing zoos around the world. Amy and two of the One Zoo Three keepers travel to Madagascar to help with planting a new forest and create breakthrough wildlife corridors for the lemurs and lots of other animals.

We welcome many new, rare and endangered animals to the zoo including cheetah brothers Mo and Bolt, a red panda called Ash and some special sand lizards. Aaron is thrilled with a first peep at their new otter pups while Cam checks in with the two snow leopard cubs to make sure they're feeling up to scratch. And we catch up with many of the One Zoo Three favourites including Mr. Jingles the sloth, Marion the Sulcata tortoise, Rambutan the binturong and the mischievous meerkat mob!

Along with meeting more dedicated keepers at the zoo, top expert Steve the Vet is on call to keep a close eye on the health of all the animals and needs to x-ray the leg of Biakal the white tiger. Top bird spotter Nadeem Perera visits to give Cam his best tips on how to spot just some of the UK's 600 native birds. And Tyler is joined by good friend and eco-champion Roma Wells. They have a plan to give the pride of lions a natural eco enrichment with a new layer of wood chips, Roma also has some eco tips for Tyler and takes him to Marwell Zoo to see how poo is turned into power to help heat some of the animal's habitats.

With remarkable, true stories about incredible animals and showing how best to look after and protect threatened species around the world along with plenty of fun, facts, entertainment and inspiration, there's lots to enjoy and take away from this latest series of One Zoo Three.
