2017 CFL DIVISION FINALS - HISTORY & TRENDS:

CFL-Wide Notes:

Single-Game Finals:

- The CFL adopted the one-game Div. Final format in the West in **1972** and the East in **1973** and thus has been in place for 45 years. (Only 1986 in the East plus 1994-95 diverted from this 4-playoff game post-season ahead of the Grey Cup)
- With Winnipeg and Hamilton out, this year will break the current run of 7 different Grey Cup winners in the last 7 years.
- **Saskatchewan** will be trying to become the first Cross-Over team to reach the Grey Cup. The first 9 teams failed to get there.
- **Saskatchewan** will be playing their 15th one-game Division Final. The Riders are 8-6 in Division Finals since 1972. (Edmonton has played the most with 31 then Montreal with 23, Calgary 21, BC 20 and Winnipeg & Toronto with 18.)
- **Calgary** will be playing their 22nd one-game Division Final and 6th in a row (2012-17). They are **10-11** in this single-game format.
- **Toronto** will be playing their 19th one-game Division Final. The Argos are **8-10** in this single-game format.
- **Edmonton** will be playing their 32nd one-game Division Final. The Riders are 18-13 in Division Finals since 1972.

Other Finals Trends:

- Calgary's **6th straight Div. Final** is one short of their team record of 7 (90-96). The CFL record is 10 in a row by Edmonton (1973-82).
- Since 1945, this will be Calgary's **36th appearance in a Western Final** (Single-game or Total Points series).
- **Toronto** enters the East Division Final for the first time since 2013 and **31st time since 1945.**
- Calgary comes into this game with a **3-game losing streak**, their longest in advance of a playoff game since **1957.**
- Edmonton comes in with a **6-game overall win streak**, the 2nd time in 3 years they have had a long winning run before the Final. (The Esko ended 2015 with an 8-game win streak before defeating Calgary 45-31 in the West Final)
- Saskatchewan has now won 3 of their last 4 games including last week. They have now **won 5 straight road games** overall.
- Both 1st place Finals home teams used their bye well in 2016 as they won at home to move onto the Grey Cup (Ottawa & Calgary).
- ALL 6 Division regular season winners won at home in the Division Finals from 2014 to 2016.

2017 EAST FINAL • Saskatchewan at Toronto:

East Division Matchup & Key Factors in the 2017 season series:

- Since 1961 (when Inter-Division play began), Saskatchewan actually holds an edge playing in Toronto - **26 wins to 21.** (By comparison in Eastern road games, the Riders are 14-24 at Montreal and 18-26 at Hamilton)
- This game pits the CFL's two best **1st Down** teams - Toronto averaged **7.00** yards per play and Saskatchewan was at **6.96.**
- It also features two teams who made dramatic **late season shifts to the run** with their offences:
TOR - Gm #1-12: **65** yds/gm; Gm #13-18: **129** yds/gm **SSK** - Gm #1-15: **70** yds/gm; Gm #16-19: **160** yds/gm (incl. S/F)
- One key 2017 difference was in **QB Sacks Made** - Toronto tied at #1 with 50, Saskatchewan ranked #8 with 27.
- Saskatchewan swept Toronto in their two-game series in 2017 and have now won the last 3 times they have played the Argos. Here is a summary of the key team vs team statistics from 2017 in their two meetings:

2017 EAST FINAL • Saskatchewan at Toronto:

East Division Matchup & Key Factors in the 2017 season series:

- Saskatchewan won both 2017 meetings despite trailing by deficits of **10 points** (Jul 29/17) and **13 points** (Oct 7/17). (Saskatchewan outscored Toronto by a combined **38 to 18 in the 2nd half** and won after trailing each game at half-time)
- The 2nd half comebacks were led first by **Kevin Glenn** (Jul 29th) and then on Oct 7th by **Brandon Bridge**. (Oct 7th: Bridge threw for 292 yards and 2 TDs off the bench leading 5 scoring drives in his 7 possessions at QB)
- Saskatchewan's strength was in **capitalizing on T/Os** - they scored 130 points after their 40 Takeaways, #2 behind Winnipeg. (On Per Takeaway basis: #1 WPG at 3.95 points, #2 SSK 3.25, #3 HAM 2.83. For Saskatchewan, 25% of their points came off T/Os)
- Including the Semi-Final Saskatchewan brings a **+15 T/O Ratio** into this game; Toronto ended up at **-3**.
- The Argos were also strong on offence vs the Riders scoring 10 times in 23 possessions (5 TDs, 5 FGs) with only 4 Two-&-Outs.
- The Riders took possession in Toronto's end 4 times and had 10 Red Zone chances to Toronto's 7. Riders average start: Own 39.
- Toronto did not start a drive in Saskatchewan's end of the field in either game and averaged starting at their own 31-yard line.
- The Argos built 5 long TD drives of 64, 62, 79, 98 and 85 yards to earn their offensive scores.
- Over the two games, Saskatchewan scored at least a field goal on 8 of their 11 drives in the 2nd half to comeback to win.
- There was only **one Turnover** combined in the two games (by Toronto). That cost 3 points but was the margin in the 27-24 Rider win.
- **Ricky Ray** threw for 300+ yards in both games with 5 TD passes and 74% completion mark.
- **James Wilder** was held to 107 yards rushing on 24 carries; the Riders are the last team to keep him under 100 yards.
- **Duron Carter** had games of 131 & 71 yards with two TD catches and 5 going for clutch 2nd down conversions.
- **S.J. Green** had games of 68 & 76 yards with two TD catches and 5 for 2nd down conversions on just 14 total targets.
- FG perfection: **Tyler Crapigna** made all 7 of his FG attempts while **Lirim Hajrullahu** went 5-for 5 on his tries.
- Coverage Units: Over the two games there was only a single "big play" return (a 45-yard K/O return by Christian Jones)
- **Bakari Grant** added 200 receiving yards on 12 catches - the most yards he had against any opponent in 2017.
- Both clubs were highly successful in **2nd-&-Long**: Toronto went 14-of-26 (54%), Saskatchewan went 12-of-26 (46%)

East Semi-Final Wrap-Up - Saskatchewan at Ottawa:

- The game featured the fastest 2 TDs in playoff history (4:07) and the fastest 3 TDs (9:06). The first 3 drives all resulted in TDs.
- Ottawa led for less than 5 minutes (4:37) while the Riders stayed ahead for the final 50:54 of the contest.
- Ottawa did not commit a single Accepted penalty, the first time that has happened in a playoff game in 47 years (CGY in 1970).
- Saskatchewan committed just 3 penalties making it the least penalized game in modern CFL history.
- **2nd-&-Long**: Saskatchewan was in 2-&-7+ yards just **9 times** (4/9), Ottawa was forced into 2-&-7+ **16 times** (3/16).
- **Turnovers**: Ottawa committed 4 T/Os and these came in scoring range (or close to it) stopping key opportunities. (Saskatchewan made these 4 Takeaways at the SSK 22, SSK 37, OTT 50 & SSK 22 yard lines)
- **2nd Down Conversions**: OTT 10-of-27 (**37%** with 3 chances in 2-&-3 or less); SSK 12-of-22 (**55%** with 8 chances in 2nd & short)
- **YAC**: Riders made 44% of their passing yards after the catch (110 of 252). Glenn tried only 4 throws deeper than 14 yards.
- **QB Pressure**: Riders made 2 QB Sacks and 10 Pressures compared to Ottawa's 0 Sacks and 6 Pressures.
- Saskatchewan had only one 2-&-Out until late in the game and built TD drives of 79, 82, 62 and 75 yards.
- **Kevin Glenn** attempted only two deep throws (0-for-2) but was 7-of-8 for 144 yards in mid-range throws. Did not throw an INT.
- Trevor Harris set a CFL Playoff record with **60 pass attempts**, 30 of which came in the 4th Quarter after trailing 31-14.
- Harris completed 37 passes (#2 all-time) for 457 yards (#6) and 2 TDs but threw 2 INTs (made at the SSK 5 & SSK 29 yard lines)
- **Marcus Thigpen** rushed for 169 yards, the 3rd-highest total in Riders history (G.Reed 204 in 1967, K.Sheets 177 in 2013).
- Four Riders caught at least 3 passes for 35+ yards spreading the offence. Spencer & Criner caught 20 of Harris' 37 completions.



2017 EAST FINAL • Saskatchewan at Toronto:

Team Notes - Toronto & Saskatchewan:

QB Comparison:

- **Ricky Ray** has started against Saskatchewan 30 times in regular season (17-13) but just once in the playoffs:
Ray wins as starter - Career Total 112. Most by Opponent: Hamilton 19, **Saskatchewan 17**, BC 15
Ray playoff starts - Career Total 13. Fewest by Opponent: **Saskatchewan 1**, Edmonton 1
(Ray's only playoff start vs Saskatchewan came 14 years ago in the 2003 West Division Final: 32-23-358, 1 TD, Won 30-23)
- **Kevin Glenn** has started against Toronto more times (32) and has more wins (20) versus the Argos than any other opponent:
Glenn wins as starter - Career Total 103. Most by Opponent: **Toronto 20**, Hamilton 15, Montreal 14
Glenn TD Passes - Career Total 293. Most by Opponent: **Toronto 44**, Edmonton 38, Saskatchewan 38
- **Kevin Glenn** has started against Toronto more times (32) and has more wins (20) versus the Argos than any other opponent.
- Ray ranks **#7** all-time in Career Playoff passing yards with 3,466 - he needs 101 yards to pass Henry Burris at #6.
- Glenn now ranks **#10** all-time in Career Playoff passing yards with 2,970 and needs 113 yards to pass Russ Jackson (3,082) at #9.
- Ray and Glenn have started against one another in the playoffs just once - in the **2008 East S/Final**: (Edm 29, Wpg 21)
Ray, EDM - 27 of 37 for 303 yds, 0 TD, 0 Int Glenn, WPG - 15 of 34 for 233 yds, 1 TD, 1 Int

Other Notes:

- This game will be the Argos first Division Final in 4 years since their back-to-back appearances in 2012-13.
- This game will be the Riders first-ever East Division Final and their first of any kind since 2013 when they won the Grey Cup.
- **Toronto rushing yards:** Last 6 J.Wilder Starts: **143.3** per game; Toronto's other 12 games: **63.7** per game.
- Toronto Net Offence: In their last 4 games Toronto went 3-1 and averaged **468** net yards per game and 29.8 first downs.
- Saskatchewan led the CFL in Touchdowns with 55, the first time as CFL leader in TDs since **2007** and **second time in 44 years**.
- **Comeback kings:** Toronto overcame deficits of 10+ points 3 times this year to win; Saskatchewan also did it 3 times this year.
- **Wire-to-wire wins:** Five of Saskatchewan's wins were wire-to-wire as they did not trail at any time during these victories.
- Saskatchewan started off 2-4 but since then have gone 9-4 in their last 13 games including the Semi-Final victory at Ottawa.
- **Chris Jones** enters his 3rd Division Final in 4 years as Head Coach; For **Marc Trestman** it will be his 5th Division Final in 6 seasons.
- Saskatchewan rushed for a season-high 212 yards last week at Ottawa and we will go against Toronto's #1 rushing defence.
- **S.J. Green** brings 462 career playoff receiving yards into this game - #4 among active players.
- **Bakari Grant** has 488 career playoff receiving yards - #3 among active players behind W.Dressler (815) and A.Bowman (596).
- **Kienan LaFrance** will be playing in his second straight East Final - he rushed for 157 yards for Ottawa in the 2016 Final.
- **Mitchell White** will also be playing in his second straight East Final - he made 5 tackles for Ottawa in the 2016 Final.
- Both kickers will make their Finals debut. Tyler Crapigna played his first playoff game last week, Lirim Hajrullahu debuts this week.
- **James Wilder** has a current two-game streak of 100+ rushing yards: 112 and 136 in Toronto's final two games.
- Ricky Ray ended the regular season with a streak of 5 straight **300+ yard games** to take the CFL lead with 13 (#2 all-time).
- Victor Butler started the year with 7 Sacks in his first 3 games. He played the final 7 games with only 2 Sacks but had 11 Pressures.
- **Shawn Lemon** had 8 Sacks in 12 games and had at least one in 7 different games including in Week #20 after returning from IL.
- **Anthony Coombs** also returned in Week #20 and was targeted 4 times making 2 catches for 1 yards.
- **Namaan Roosevelt** returned from missing three games and in the Semi-Final made 4 catches on 6 targets for 55 yards.

HISTORICAL NOTES:

- Canadian Football governing bodies were the CRU (Canadian Rugby Union) until 1955, and the CFC (Canadian Football Council) for 1956-57. The CFC was renamed the Canadian Football League in January 1958.
- The present-day CFL East Division was formed from the long-standing IRFU founded in 1907. It was renamed the Eastern Conference in 1960 and the East Division in 1981. The CFL West Division was formed as the WIFU in 1936, renamed the Western Conference in 1961, and the West Division in 1981.
- Division Semi-Finals have been held in the one-game format across the CFL since 1965. The two-game format was used in the East only in 1951 and in the West from 1952 to 1964.
- In the East, Division Finals were staged as a 2-game total point series in most seasons from 1936 to 1972. The East adopted the one-game final format in 1973 with the exception of 1986 when there was a two-game final only.
- In the West, Division Finals were staged as a two-game total point series in most years from 1936 to 1949 (1947 required a third game to break a tie). From 1950 to 1971, West Division Finals were staged as best-of-three series. The one-game final format began in 1972 in the West.
- ORFU champions played IRFU winners from 1945 to 1952 and the WIFU final winners in 1953 and 1954.
