

The Belfry is always active in developing new plays. Our role takes many forms – dramaturgy, workshops and readings – and each aspect requires some financial investment.



CREATIVE TEAM

Lucy Kirkwood Playwright

Lucy Kirkwood is an East London born playwright. She won the PMA award in 2006. She is a writer on the Channel 4 programme *Skins* and is currently resident writer at Clean Break theatre company. Her first full professional production, *Tinderbox*, was directed by Josie Rourke and performed at the Bush Theatre, London, in 2008. Her adaption of Henrik Ibsen's *Hedda Gabler*, entitled *Hedda*, was directed by Carrie Cracknell and performed at the Gate Theatre later that year. She is currently working on a Sloan commission for the Manhattan Theatre Club and a full-length one-woman show for Clean Break, as well as various television and film projects.



Christina Poddubiuk Set & Costume Designer

Christina returns to the Belfry, having previously designed A Doll's House, Part 2, Venus in Fur and A Tender Thing. Recent credits include Private Lives, Julius Caesar (Stratford Festival) and La Traviata for a five-city Canadian tour. Other theatres: Romeo and Juliet, John Gabriel Borkman, Phèdre (also A.C.T.) and many others for the Stratford Festival. For the Shaw Festival, Pygmalion, Faith Healer, Come Back Little Sheba, A Moon for the Misbegotten, Major Barbara, The Heiress and others. Opera includes Don Quichotte and Béatrice et Bénédict (Canadian Opera Company), and Lucia de Lammermoor, Tosca and Capriccio (Pacific Opera Victoria).



Alan Brodie Lighting Designer

Alan is delighted to return to the Belfry, where his credits include Mustard, A Christmas Carol, Alice Munro Stories, I Think I'm Fallin': The Songs of Joni Mitchell, Equivocation, Stones in His Pockets, The Syringa Tree, Mary's Wedding, When We Were Singing, The Drawer Boy, Two, Skylight, Come Rain or Come Shine, Anatol and The Collected Works of Billy the Kid. A member of the Associated Designers of Canada, Alan lives in Vancouver with his wife Michele. He was a 2016 MFA directing grad of the Phoenix at UVic and he recently directed The Drawer Boy for Ensemble Theatre Company and Wit for Peninsula Productions.



Tobin Stokes Composer & Sound Designer
