# War On Waste

The convenient plastic bag is everywhere, and seems harmless enough, but their impact on the environment is huge. Craig dives underwater to discover the shocking amount of plastic waste that ends up in our oceans, which in turn becomes ingested by our marine life. Craig sets off to explore the effect of banning plastic bags in some states, and the alarming way some businesses get around it.

## You Can't Ask That

In this episode, we ask children of same-sex parents to address one of the most hotly debated and controversial issues of our time - their life.

Lakshmi Holmes from Melbourne addresses some of the outside judgements made on her, "There was this flyer 'Kids with gay parents are the next stolen generation'. That's the most hurtful and offensive thing I've ever read. Not just to kids like us but to the whole indigenous community. I don't want someone who's never walked a day in our shoes to say that 'This isn't right. This is disgusting. This is unnatural'." she says.

Asked 'How awkward was it telling your friends your parents were gay?' Jesse Wakeling from Sydney says that his two mums told him "I know it seems weird but you've got to do this to protect yourself. Call Margaret, Aunty, and me, Mum. And if people ask, she's my sister and she lives with us."

While most are advocates for same-sex parenting, Millie Fontana from Melbourne feels differently. When asked 'Are you always looking for a mother or father figure to replace the one you don't have?' She responds, "I had issues with fatherlessness. As a child I would cling to men in other families. I couldn't replace my actual father; it was still quite obvious to me that there was a lot missing." she says.

"I've been out as a child of gay parents for 25 years, and it's a story I like to tell." says Tim Hughes who grew up in the 1980's with two dads. "We just want the rest of the world to come on board and say 'Yes, you are a family'.
