Clean up this Christmas with Vorwerk

-Brand behind cult Thermomix kitchen aid reveals the speedy cleaning gadgets that should be on every tech lover's Christmas list-

Featuring a robot cleaner that memorises your house, a vacuum that mops and sucks up dirt simultaneously and an almost-waterless window cleaner, Vorwerk's garage of gadgets deliver a tidy home with a techy twist.



[Kobold VR200 Robot vacuum cleaner - £749](#)

Equally at home in uber modern city pads and country cottages, the VR200 uses 60-degree laser navigation to scan the room 1,800 times per second, creates a precise map and memorise it.

A handy schedule function means you can set the VR200 to clean your home while you're out at work, and the neat climb assist feature makes it easy to overcome obstacles of up to 2cm.

A 90 minute battery life means it can clean up to 120sqm on a single charge.

[Kobold VC100 Handheld Vacuum Cleaner - £149](#)

Slim, sleek and elegant, the VC100 and its accompanying charging station not only deliver a powerful performance but look good too.

Made from a high quality, durable white gloss thermoformed plastic and weighing only 750g – the rough equivalent of two cans of Coke – the VC100 is the must-have alternative to the traditional dust pan and brush.

Two variable suction levels, mean it can clean everything from delicate laptop keys through dried in mud in your car.





Kobold VG100 window cleaner



The perfect solution for those of us that want shiny windows without the strain, the VG100 lets you clean your glass using just one hand.

Simply add water and cleaning fluid, power up the motor and glide the VG100 over up to 20sqm of glass on one 30 minute charge.

A microfibre towel removes the dirt from your window, and the motor will suck away the dirty water in an instant leaving you with perfectly clean, streak free windows.

Then, simply chuck the cloth in the washing machine and charge the battery for next time!

Kobold VK200 Ultimate Homecare System – from £749

Dubbed the ‘Rolls-Royce’ of vacuum cleaners thanks to its class leading ability to deep clean almost any surface in your home, the Kobold VK200 is Vorwerk’s piece de resistance.



The standard Automatic Electric Brush uses ultrasonic sensors that detect the floor type and activate the optimum performance power and floor setting automatically, and the VF200 Carpet Freshener applies a dry cleaning agent to carpets that is then vacuumed away to leave a deep cleaned carpet pile.

The icing on the cake is Vorwerk’s SP530 DuoClean head that will mop and vacuum hard floors at the same time, saving you precious time (and effort!). Ideal for cleaning up muddy



paw prints from the kitchen or wine stains on the laminate, the DuoClean glides across the floor making the mop and bucket somewhat redundant.
